As we start the New Year here are some reminders to keep the momentum going:

- The Board meetings are usually held the 1st Wednesday of the month poolside
- General Trash Pick-up Mondays
- Trash, Recyclables and Yard Waste Pick-up Thursdays
- Yard waste (leaves, clippings, branches, etc. can be placed at the curb Wednesday evening at the earliest.
- Cans etc. may be put on the curb **the night before pick-up**, and removed by **the evening of pick-up**.

- At all other times trash cans, waste bags, etc. need to be out of sight from the street. They
 are to be kept behind a fence, walled area, back yard or in the garage. Visible trash, trash
 cans, bags, etc. has become an unsightly situation in Beckett Bay which affects all our
 residents.
- Cars and trucks are **not** to be parked on the grass either in yards or on the easement.
- Commercial vehicles are **not** to be parked overnight in Beckett Bay.
- Clean up after your dogs, and try to keep your animals from roaming into others yards.
